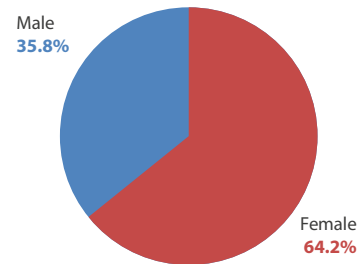

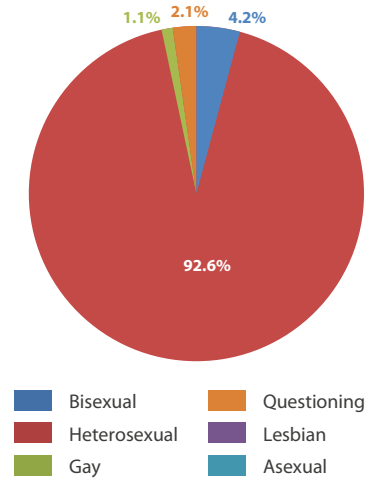

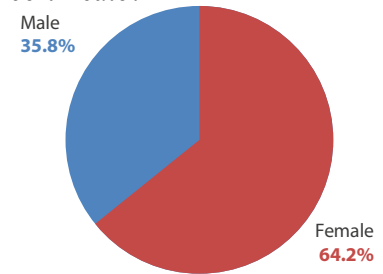

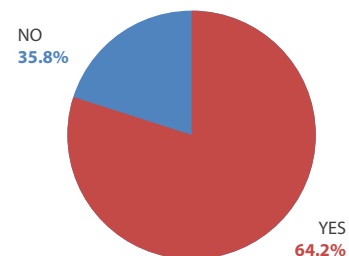

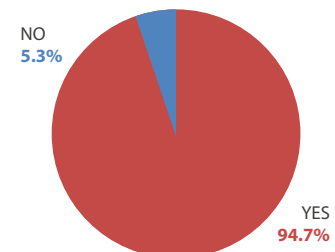

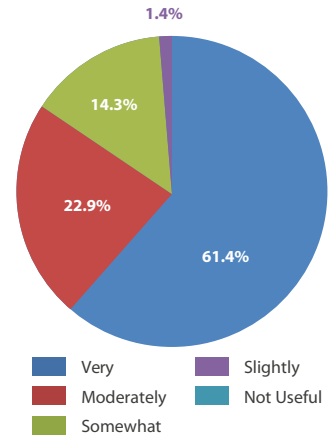
8. Have you been educated about Sexual Harassment, Sexual Assault, Stalking, Domestic Violence, and Dating Violence?

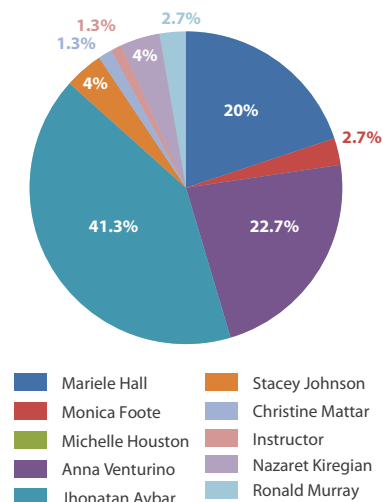

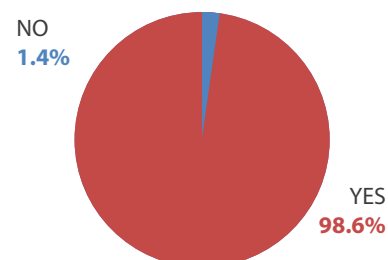

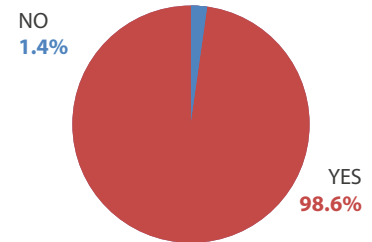
