The Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC/Commission) received Long Island Business Institute's (LIBI) January 19, 2024, request to voluntarily withdraw from ACCJC's membership, effective January 27, 2024.

The request to voluntarily withdraw comes after LIBI's brief transition of accreditation to ACCJC from the New York State Board of Regents and Commissioner of Education. The New York State Board of Regents voted to not pursue their continued recognition by the United States Department of Education (ED) in October 2021, and recognition was withdrawn as of May 10, 2023. The Commission recognizes that over the past year, all LIBI students have been notified of the institution's pursuits of ACCJC accreditation, and all the students have been provided options for teach out. Per your letter dated January 19, 2024, ACCJC understands that SUNY Empire and Five Towns College have committed to delivering LIBI's curriculum utilizing LIBI's faculty for academic activities, and of the 578 students who received teach-out options, all but 72 have opted into continuing their education; these 72 students will continue to have the opportunity to enroll at both institutes in the summer semester and again in the fall of 2024. Additionally, ACCJC understands from your letter dated January 19, 2024, that the institution has not been admitting new students since September 2023, and has had no instruction scheduled for the coming term.

The ACCJC Executive Committee took action to accept LIBI's request to voluntarily withdraw from membership, effective January 22, 2024. Per federal policy, the Commission will notify the U.S. Secretary of Education and other officials of ED, appropriate state licensing and/or authorizing agencies, and the appropriate accrediting bodies. The Commission requires you submit a closure plan to ACCJC by February 2, 2024.

In keeping with ACCJC policy, the Commission action will also be posted on the ACCJC website within 30 days of the date of the action. ACCJC requires you disclose the Commission's action to all current and prospective students within seven business days of receipt of the Commission's action.

LIBI will no longer be listed as a current member institution on the ACCJC directory. However, the college will be included in the list of previously accredited institutions maintained on the ACCJC website.

On behalf of the Commission and ACCJC staff, we hope LIBI's faculty and staff will continue their work educating students, and the students who have found new institutions to complete their course work will achieve their educational goals.
